Apply foam generously and let it dwell. Most bays give you a foam mode — use it liberally and allow the foam to sit on the surface for at least 30 to 60 seconds before rinsing. This gives the chemicals time to break down road grime and organic contaminants.

Work from top to bottom. Gravity is your friend. Washing from the roof down to the lower panels prevents dirty water from contaminating areas you have already cleaned.

Pay attention to wheels and tyres. These are typically the dirtiest parts of the car. Many bays offer a dedicated tyre cleaner or degreaser mode — use it before working on the bodywork so that brake dust and oil do not transfer to the paint.

Use the final rinse wisely. A spot-free or deionised rinse, where available, will help prevent water spots from forming as the car dries — particularly important in Singapore's mineral-rich tap water environment.

Bring a microfibre towel. While some facilities have air dryers, bringing your own clean microfibre drying towel will give you a streak-free finish and protect your paint from swirl marks.

The Future of Car Wash Technology in Singapore

App-connected car wash machines that allow users to book a bay, pay remotely, and monitor their wash in real time are already in use at select locations.
