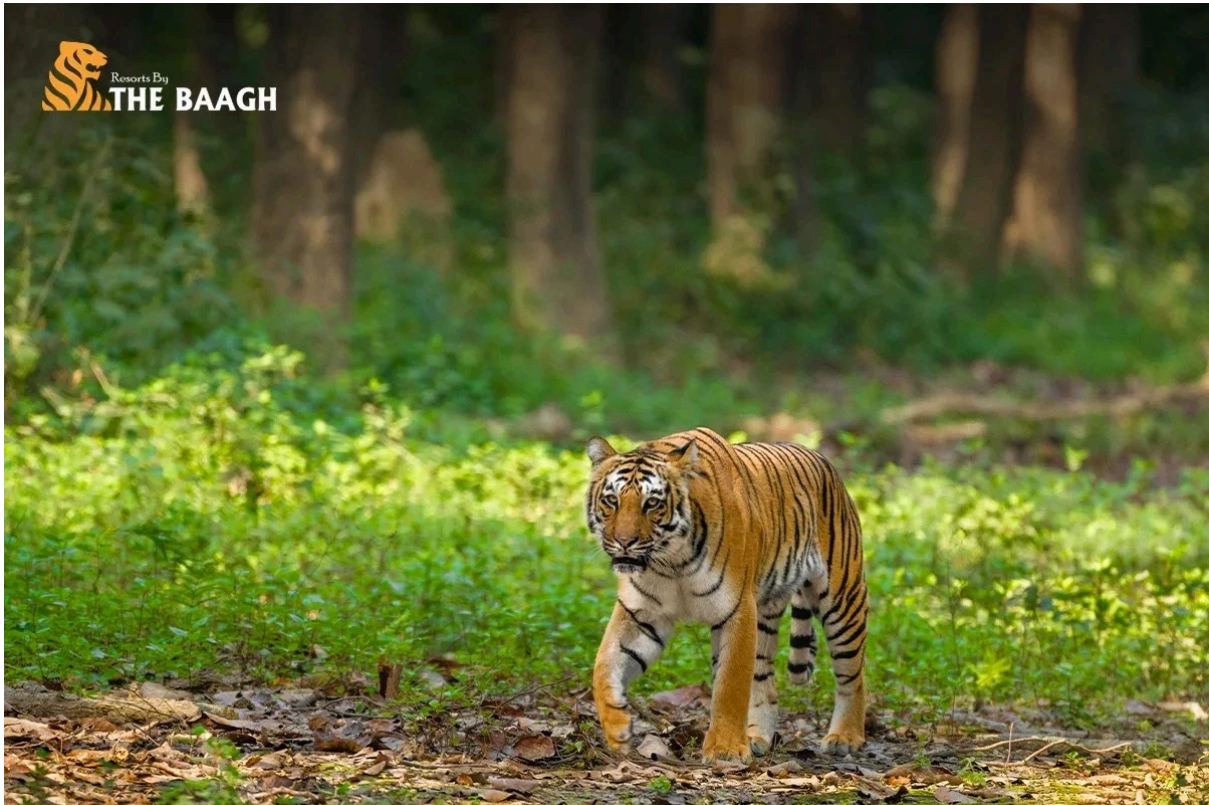

- Established in 1936: The park was first created as Hailey National Park to protect the land. It became the very first national park in Asia.
- Renamed After Independence: The park was renamed as Ramganga National Park in 1954. This name came from the beautiful river that flows through the forest.

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
